I will not be able to take cash to payments.** Agents, if you would like for us to IDT your registration fee and or your officer fees, please let Sarah Williams know.

Your registration must be entered here: [Spring Planning Meeting Registration Link](#) no later than March 16, 2020. This is a firm deadline due to rooming lists being due. Registration covers the following: Lodging (2 per room), dinner Saturday evening, Saturday's evening activity, facilities, program supplies as well as snacks and insurance.

Be sure to bring the following items with you: clothes appropriate for a 4-H event, toiletry items, paper, pencil and your calendar. Jeans and t-shirts are fine to wear for this weekend as long as they meet the 4-H dress code guidelines. *Part of the Saturday evening activity will be outside so please plan accordingly.

Our planning meeting will be held at the Creative Studio inside the Hunt Library on NC State's Centennial Campus. If you haven't been to the Hunt library you're in for a treat and we have an *amazing* space for our meeting. Lodging will be at the Holiday Inn Express Hotel & Suites 3741 Thistledown Road, I-40, Exit 295 Raleigh, NC 27606 (approximately 2.4 miles from Centennial Campus / 7 minute drive).
