District Timeline

- **June 15 - Registration/uploaded**
- Use week of the 22nd for DAD Judging ONLY - Youth and Agents not involved in this - just the PIC's, Judges and State Staff facilitating

 - June 26 - W
- July 3rd - Score Sheets back to counties so winners can re-do their recording based on judges' feedback

- State 4-H Presentation Guidelines & Regulations & Categories

- Videos of youth presenting their presentations
 - Videos must be single cut - do not do several recordings and splice them together. SINGLE CUT ONLY - just as if youth are presenting live.
- Must see youth doing their presentations.
- Teams - use zoom or something similar to record you both on the screen at the same time.(Use co-host to share the roles)
- Videos can not be bigger than 10GB - smaller is better
- Videos must be .mp4 file format or .mov as these are universal and we should be able to open them easily. We do not want links to a youtube channel or anything else. Please upload the video directly in the google registration. I will send that out separately.

General Notes

- Shannon will work to see if EIT can provide training for Agents/PA's on videoing. How to save it as .mp4, how to help youth save it.
- Allow your 4-H'ers to be creative in how they manage this new way of doing things this year. An example of this is that we know they do not have "easels" at home so use a chair, use a person, whatever works to make a smooth transition from face to face to recorded videos.

County Activity Day - how to handle

- All Virtual County Activity Days
 - Zoom
 - Recorded Videos
 - Other Platforms approved by EIT or your County IT

DAD

- Presenters submit a video recording of their presentation to their agent.
- Agents will upload video at designated time using the designated process – June 15
- Judges will judge presentations - submit questions on the score sheets.
- Score sheets will be returned to 4-H Agent - ASAP especially for winners.
- For State Finals: Use questions from the District Judging and answer those questions in your re-recorded presentation for State judging. Be sure to say in recording that the judges had these questions from the district and you are answering them if that is applicable.
- Winners will be announced with some type of "virtual" ceremony with winners.
 - District Officers will be involved in this process.

State Finals

- Same rules apply as outlined above.
- Gold - 8-10, 11-13, 14-18 and Silver Winners in 11-13, 14-18 will be allowed to review score sheets and re-record their presentation based on scoresheet feedback.
- Winners will submit videos to agents at designated time using the designated process
- Agents will upload videos using a google registration link provided by Shannon by July 20th.
- Judges will judge presentations - July 28th or during the week of the 28th. Still working on final details of the when.
- Winners are announced as soon as possible after judging is complete.

Outdoor Cookery

- Held at a later time - sometime in the fall – we are still working on this plan. We cannot really have this one until we can meet face to face.
- Same rules will apply.
- The Committee is still developing this plan

4-H Entertains

 - Showcase during National 4-H Week - (The Committee is still developing this plan along with Mark Dearmon but we are looking at a virtual talent show or other options using a variety of acts from the District Competitions)

National 4-H Presentation/Outdoor Cookery Contest
