## 2021 HOSTING PERIOD July 24<sup>th</sup>(arrival) to August 18<sup>th</sup>(departure)

- You can host a youth aged 12-18 (most are 12-14) or an adult chaperone.
- Youth have a range of English language abilities, so host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively.

## **HOST FAMILY REQUIREMENTS**

- You must have a child of the same gender who is <u>within 4 years</u> of the hosted youth (children aged 9+ are eligible to host).
- Families without children of the appropriate age <u>may host an adult</u> <u>chaperone</u> for 2 or 4 week stay.
- <u>Complete an application</u> and <u>successfully pass</u> a background screening and home visit.
- <u>Attend required</u> host family orientations and gatherings.
- <u>No special activities</u> need to be planned since these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family.
- This is a voluntary program; no stipends will be provided.
- It is <u>not required</u> to be involved with 4-H to be considered.
