2021 HOSTING PERIOD

July 24th(arrival) to August 18th(departure)

- You can host a youth aged 12-18 (most are 12-14) or an adult chaperone.
- Youth have a range of English language abilities, so host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively.

HOST FAMILY REQUIREMENTS

- You must have a child of the same gender who is within 4 years of the hosted youth (children aged 9+ are eligible to host).
- Families without children of the appropriate age may host an adult chaperone for 2 or 4 week stay.
- Complete an application and successfully pass a background screening and home visit.
- Attend required host family orientations and gatherings.
- No special activities need to be planned since these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family.
- This is a voluntary program; no stipends will be provided.
- **It is not required to be involved with 4-H to be considered.**
