

## North Carolina 4-H Youth Development Declaration of Intent to Compete in a County of Non-Enrollment Policy

This policy addresses the need for youth, families, and staff to clearly understand youth competing in 4-H programs outside of their primary enrollment county.

This policy is to ensure that youth have equitable programmatic opportunities. It is not to be used for competitive advantage and must be renewed annually.

Reasons a youth may need/wish to compete in a program outside of their primary enrollment county could include:

- Youth live close to county lines.
- Due to unique programmatic opportunities, youth may choose to participate in another county 4-H program.
- Opportunities in multi-county programs due to CES Staffing.
