- Address problems that are brought to my attention.
- Not share my personal information, email, or social media accounts with minor participants.
- Not share links or passwords for Program meetings or content.
- Not “friend,” “follow” or “like” minors from the Program on social media.
- Dress appropriately when on video.
- Not record or take screenshots or images of participants unless directed to do so for Program purposes.
- Not use Program content, contacts, images or video for personal use outside the scope of the Program.
- Work with Program staff to resolve issues that may arise.

The following may result in being dismissed from the program:

- Bullying, harassing or using derogatory language towards another person or group of people.
- Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while participating in a 4-H event or program.

- Repeated absences or failure to meet agreed upon program work requirements.
- Violation of a University code, policy, or regulation.
- Recording or sharing Program related information outside the scope of the Program.
